Lost someone or something?

Identity wristbands are available at the festival entrance. If your child becomes lost our friendly scarecrows will be able to contact you & will wait with children at the Information Hut. Lost property will be taken to the Information Hut for your collection.

City Loop Bus service

The City Loop Bus circles Warrnambool's CBD, taking in the train station and accommodation hubs. Services operate regularly between 9:00am to 5:30pm daily.



Free Park n' Ride shuttle

Park your car at Shipwreck Bay Caravan Park, Pertobe Road and the FREE shuttle will whisk you to the festival site, running continuously from 9:30am to 5:30pm daily.



Parking

Free parking is available at Flagstaff Hill, Merri Street and Cannon Hill.



First-Aid

First-Aid is located at the festival entrance. There are also First-Aid Officers roaming the festival - they will be wearing First-Aid badges.



Food & beverages

You're welcome to bring a packed lunch from home but please note that take-away is not allowed to be brought into the festival. There are a variety of food and beverage options available throughout the festival to keep little tummies full.

OCEANARIUM:

Be part of an underwater adventure

Fun4Kids welcomes Oceanarium, a major innovative local arts project featuring a combination of textile art, sculpture and video to recreate the sensory richness of Warrnambool's unique marine environment.

Children will be able to explore the wonders and diversity of the underwater world through interactive features and activities within four different marine biomes; Rocky Shore Wonder Place, Deep Ocean Other World, Woven Forest Whale Sanctuary and Open Ocean Video Sphere.

Four local artists working across textiles, mixed media sculpture and film have partnered with marine biologists from Warrnambool's Deakin University to create interconnected art spaces that generate one cohesive marine installation, with the project attracting \$66,000 in federal government funding from Festivals Australia, as well as funding contributed from state government and local philanthropic trusts to help implement this one-of-a-kind project.

Oceanarium emerged from the joy and wonder lead artist Becky Nevin Berger experienced when visiting Warrnambool's rock pools with her young family. Realising that wintry weather prohibited families, visiting the region for the Fun4Kids Festival, from experiencing the rock pools led to the idea of instead simulating this environment indoors.

A curated program of community events has enabled community members to participate in and contribute to Oceanarium in the lead-up to the festival. In forming collaborations with artists, marine biologists, Fun4Kids Festival management and other community partners, the project has engaged more than 500 people in the community through several community participation workshops and public contributions, celebrating and enriching local knowledge, culture, community and landscape.
